## **RMHC Guidelines for Giving**

## **Funding Considerations:**

To be considered for funding, an organization must be designated as not-for-profit and tax-exempt as defined under IRS codes-they must have a 501c3 ruling.

## **RMHC Funds Programs that:**

- Promote health, education, cultural arts, and social well-being for children
- Directly benefit children
- Exhibits consistent and effective management
- Has clear goals and objectives
- Requests funds for support of specific, detailed programs and has itemized expenses for the program
- Demonstrates the ability to respond to needs of a specific group of children in a manner that yields measurable results

## **RMHC Does NOT Fund:**

- Advertising or fundraising drives
- Partisan, political or denominational programs
- General and administrative costs
- Intermediary funding agencies
- Endowment or capital campaigns-"bricks and mortar" projects
- Ongoing salaries or travel expenses
- Requests not in writing
- Uniforms for extra-curricular activities
